Today's Application (#2)

- Today SeaScape applied this year's second fertilizer treatment. In addition, broadleaf weed control was applied. Many lawns also received a second application of crabgrass control. This was done automatically if we felt that your lawn had a high potential for crabgrass this year. A few other notes about today's application:
- The second application of crabgrass control will minimize crabgrass later this season. No crabgrass preventer, however, will stop crabgrass in bare areas, or if you are mowing your lawn too short.
- Weed control takes up to 3 weeks to be effective. In fact, weeds such as dandelions flower more after a control application. Be patient and weeds will be controlled.
- If you are a Bronze, Gold or Platinum program customer, you'll receive a grub proofing treatment with your next application. If you are a Premium or Silver program customer, you may want to consider adding this treatment. Please call our office for more information.
- Information was left at the time of the last application on flea and tick control. It's not too late to order this service. Please give us a call to order or for more information.

What you need to do until our next visit:

- Lawns are actively growing, and mowing height is critical. Please mow high (2"-3") for a greener lawn this summer. Start mowing high NOW and do not wait until warm weather to mow high.
- We recommend that grass clippings be left on your lawn. Clippings do not contribute to thatch, and they will prolong turf color as they decompose.
- We are entering the season where your lawn may require some watering to stay green. If we go for much more than a week without rain, lawns may begin to turn brown and become dormant. SeaScape's program will be adjusted to adapt to these conditions and to protect your lawn from insects, which can be active during drought periods.

Insects & Diseases

| Pest | Plants affected | Symptoms |
|------------------------|--|--|
| Winter moth | Apple/crabapple, oak, maple, beech | Tiny larvae in buds. Caterpillars consume newly emerging leaves. Can defoliate and weaken trees. |
| Hemlock woolly adelgid | Hemlock | White cottony mass at the base of needles in the spring. |
| Elongate scale | Hemlock | Brown oblong scales on the underside of needles. |
| Scale | Hollies | Dark brown dots underneath leaves, which appear stippled. |
| Scale | Euonymus vine | White dots on the underside of the leaves, which appear stippled. |
| White prunicola scale | Cherry, lilac | White cottony mass that appears along the stems and branches. |
| Azalea bark scale | Rhododendron, azalea | Blackened bark and leaves by sooty mold. Scale is white. |
| Lace bug | Mt. Andromeda, azaleas | In mid summer, leaves look stippled often turning silvery with bad infestations. Tiny insect with transparent lacey wings. |
| Spider mite | Alberta spruce, spruces, hemlock, burning bush | Tiny red 8-legged spiders usually found by knocking a branch onto a white paper and observing the moving dots. |
| Cedar Rust | Apple, hawthorns | Small orange spots enlarge causing premature leaf drop. |
| Apple Scab | Apples/crabapples | Early brown spots enlarge causing premature leaf drop. |
| Anthracnose | Dogwood | Early brown edges on leaves envelopes entire leaf and spreads to and kills twigs and branches. |
| Needle cast | Pine, spruce, Douglas fir | Second year needles turn brown and prematurely drop. |
| Twig blight | Juniper | The tips of low growing horizontal junipers turn brown and dieback. Tiny black dots often seen on infected branches. |

Tick & Flea Control

Ticks

Unfortunately, ticks are a fact of life here in New England. Ticks are the second highest carrier of diseases (mosquitoes are the first) and nearly 90% of all Lyme disease cases come from New England. If you have a child, pet or simply like to spend time outdoors you've most likely had encounters with these disease carrying arachnids. Ticks can generally be found in taller grass, shrubbery and brushy areas. Protect your children and pets from Lyme disease carrying ticks with SeaScape's Tick Control Program.



Fleas

Fleas live in your grass and dirt and thrive during hot, humid weather. Their bites can cause skin irritations to your family and pets, and can also transfer the tapeworm parasite.



SeaScape's Tick & Flea Control Program consists of 3 applications of insect control to minimize tick and flea populations. All lawn areas as well as 5'-10' into bordering wooded areas will be treated. These applications will be performed in conjunction with your 2nd, 3rd and 4th lawn care treatments.

Due to the mobility of these insects 100% control cannot be expected. The intention of this program is to minimize the population of ticks and fleas on your property, therefore, significantly reducing potential exposure to your family and pets.

Mosquito Control

Mosquitoes are the number one carrier of diseases (followed closely by the tick). Believe it or not mosquito borne illnesses are responsible for more deaths worldwide than any other factor. Mosquitoes transmit many diseases including malaria, yellow fever, dengue fever and encephalitis. Plus, they transmit tapeworms to your pets. SeaScape's Mosquito Control Program will help control these annoying and potentially dangerous insects. Up to 5 monthly applications will be made May through September when risk of exposure is highest. Applications will be made to the lawn, shrubs, trees, wood line and under decks. We will also inspect your property and make recommendations to reduce possible breeding grounds.

What will it cost?
